1. PLAYING TIMES PER QUARTER AS FOLLOWS:

5-6 YR OLDS (BOYS)	6 MINUTES	HALF CT PRESS	8FT GOAL	27" INTERMEDIATE BALL

1. BIRTH DATE AS OF SEPTEMBER 1st OF REGISTRATION YEAR DETERMINES AGE GROUP PLAYER QUALIFIES FOR THAT SEASON.
2. RUNNING CLOCK UNTIL THE LAST 2 MINUTES OF GAME. EACH TEAM IS AUTHORIZED THREE FULL MINUTE AND TWO HALF MINUTE TIMEOUTS PER GAME. OVERTIMES WILL BE THREE MINUTES IN DURATION WITH RUNNING CLOCK UNTIL LAST MINUTE. EACH TEAM WILL RECEIVE ONE FULL TIMEOUT PER OVERTIME PERIOD. TIMEOUTS DO NOT CARRY OVER FROM REGULATION GAME.
3. EVERY MEMBER OF THE TEAM HAS TO PLAY EQUIVALENT OF AT LEAST 1 QUARTER OF EVERY GAME. *NOTE:* 5-6 BOYS AND 5-7 GIRLS MUST PLAY AT LEAST 1/2 OF EVERY GAME; SUBSTITUTIONS IN THESE GAMES WILL BE AT THE END OF EACH QUARTER. NO CHILD WILL PLAY 4 QUARTERS UNTIL EVERY OTHER CHILD HAS PLAYED 3 QUARTERS.
4. FOR ILLEGAL DEFENSES, THE REFEREE WILL STOP PLAY AND SEND THE DEFENDING TEAM DOWN COURT (NO TECHNICAL FOUL).
5. FOR COED (5-7 GIRLS AND 5-6 BOYS) THERE IS A SHORTEND FREE THROW LINE, BOYS AGE GROUP 7-8 AND GIRLS 8-11.5, FREE THROWS WILL BE ATTEMPTED FROM 13' 6". ALL OTHER LEAGUES ABOVE WILL USE THE REGULATION LINE.
6. OFFENSIVE PLAYERS MAY NOT REMAIN IN THE LANE FOR MORE THAN 3 SECONDS. SHOT ATTEMPTS STOP THE 3 SECOND COUNT.
7. REFEREES IN THE BOYS 5-6 AND GIRLS 5-7 LEAGUES WILL USE THEIR JUDGEMENT WHEN CALLING THE GAME. THE INTENT IS TO CALL THE GAME IN A MANNER THAT ALLOWS A FLOW OF ACTIVITY AND TO GIVE ALL OF THE CHILDREN AN OPPORTUNITY TO ADVANCE THE BALL TOWARDS THEIR BASKET WITHOUT EXCESSIVE CALLS FOR VIOLATIONS.
8. COACHES/ PARENTS WILL REFRAIN FROM QUESTIONING THE REFEREE'S ABOUT CALL'S DURING LIVE GAME ACTIVITY. COACHES MAY REQUEST EXPLANATION OF CALLS/NON-CALLS DURING TIMEOUTS, BETWEEN QUARTERS, OR AT END OF A GAME ONLY.
9. COACHES/PARENTS YELLING AT THE REFEREE'S MAY WARRANT THE COACH RECEIVING A WARNING OR A TECHNICAL FOUL FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE; A SECOND TECHNICAL FOUL ON THE COACH WILL RESULT IN THEIR EJECTION FROM THE GYM. AN OFFENDING PARENT SHOULD BE ASKED TO BE QUIET OR LEAVE THE GYM PRIOR TO ISSUING ANY TECHNICAL FOUL(S) TO COACH. IF EJECTED, THE COACH WILL BE SUSPENDED FOR AN ADDITIONAL GAME.
10. COACHES MUST CONTROL PLAYERS & PARENTS DURING GAMES. HEAD REFEREE AND COMMISSIONER WILL DISCUSS ANY MISCONDUCT WITH COACHES OR PLAYERS AND COULD LEAD TO A SUSPENSION.

11. IF A COACH OR PLAYER IS EJECTED FROM A GAME, THEY WILL AUTOMATICALLY MISS THE NEXT GAME.

12. ALL EMERGENCY INSURANCE INFORMATION WILL BE IN THE NYSA OFFICE.

RULES OF THE COURT

1. ABSOLUTLY NO PROFANITY
2. ONLY PLAYERS AND COACHES AROUND BENCHES; COACHES MAY BE JOINED BY A SINGLE ASSISTANT COACH AND ONLY ONE COACH MAY STAND DURING THE GAME. STANDING COACH MUST REMAIN WITHIN CONFINES OF THE COACHES BOX WHICH IS CLEARLY MARKED ON THE FLOOR.
3. NO FREE PLAY BETWEEN QUARTERS, TIMEOUTS. ONLY CURRENT PLAYERS MAY WARM-UP BETWEEN HALVES.
4. ONLY TIME/SCORE KEEPERS AT TABLE (A TRAINEE MAY BE ALSO ALLOWED).
5. NO OUTSIDE BASKETBALLS ON COURT.
6. NO HANGING ON THE RIMS.
7. NO DUNKING DURING WARM-UPS
8. ALL BASKETBALLS PUT AWAY AFTER WARM-UPS
9. NO FIGHTING
10. UNIFORMS MAY NOT BE ALTERED IN ANY WAY.
11. NO YOUNGER CHILDREN CAN BE LEFT UNATTENDED.

CLEANUP

1. TEAMS WILL BE ASSIGNED SPECIFIC CLEANUP DATES AND COACHES WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR GETTING PARENTS TO VOLUNTEER IN A POSITIVE MANNER IN ORDER TO ENSURE OUR GYM IS KEPT UP TO STANDARDS.
2. COACHES WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR POLICING THEIR OWN BENCH AREA AT THE END OF EACH GAME FOR TRASH, CLOTHING, EQUIPMENT, DRINKS, FOOD, ETC. MOP UP ANY SPILLS WITH THE MOP LOCATED BEHIND THE SCORER'S TABLE.
